Handling and Application

- This product is suitable for cold lamination using a laminator.
- Ensure that the material has reached room temperature and a relative humidity of 50% before use.
- Allow the inks to cure before overlaminating, this is usually 24-48 hours. (Not applicable to HP Latex prints). Failure to do so can cause delamination, tunnelling and shrinkage.
- The matched laminate for MDC and is MetaGuard MGC.

- Suitable for use on Solvent, UV and Latex prints.
- The product is matched to MetaCast[®]. Matched laminates prevent tunnelling and delamination.
- Apply around 30°C on the top roller to prevent silvering of the adhesive.

- The user should determine suitability of the overlaminate to the print media
